This year’s theme “Immigration: An American Snapshot” will help students explore the topic of immigration and its impact on contemporary society. Through the use of historical and individual accounts of previous generations, the struggles they endured, and successes they achieved, students will develop an understanding of how immigration has come to influence the cultural, economic, political and social landscape of our nation.

Students will:

- Identify the causes of immigration, in particular the primary “push” & “pull” factors
- Describe the impact (culturally, economically, politically, socially) that immigrants have had in shaping society
- Analyze the cycles of immigration throughout modern US history (1600 to present)
- Explain the “Americanization Process” that immigrants face when entering the United States (past & present)
- Compare the arguments for & against immigration as it relates to today’s social climate
