

Professional dress guidelines for faculty and staff

To assist colleagues in making appropriate attire choices and to promote positive, professional identification with the school, we offer the following dress guidelines. If you have questions about these guidelines, please ask. Ultimately, the Principal will determine the appropriateness of all attire.

For women:

Unless required otherwise by job responsibilities:

- Short or long-sleeved dress shirt, sweater, or blouse that does not reveal cleavage, back, midriff, shoulders, or undergarments
- Dress or skirt no shorter than just above the knee
- Dress, chino, or khaki slacks or capris (no blue jeans)
- Leggings under dresses or skirts as described above
- No visible piercings other than in the ear
- Hair should be neat, clean, and in natural color(s).
- Loafers, flats, dress shoes, dress sandals, or dress boots

On selected days as determined by the Principal:

- Dress slacks, skirts, or dresses
- Tops as described above
- Loafers, flats, dress shoes, or dress boots

For men:

Unless required otherwise by job responsibilities:

- Dress shirt or polo shirt
- Dress, chino, or khaki slacks with belt (no blue jeans or cargo pants)
- No visible piercings
- Hair should be neat and clean, in natural color(s), and no longer than the top of the collar.
- Men should have a definitive facial hairstyle: either clean-shaven or facial hair that is fully established by the start of the school year or upon return from school breaks.
- Loafers, dress shoes, or dress boots

On selected days as determined by the Principal:

- Dress shirt with tie
- Dress slacks
- Loafers, dress shoes, or dress boots
