1. Check the exam schedule carefully. If you have a conflict, submit an [Exam Conflict Form](#) online **by Monday, May 6, 2019**.
2. Seniors report directly to the exam room. Seniors who come late to an exam forfeit the time missed. Seniors remain in the exam room for the entire time and may leave school when all of their exams for the day have been completed. Seniors who need to wait for a later exam may report to the Learning Commons for silent study. Seniors **may not** wait in their cars.
3. Students who miss an exam because of illness must have a doctor's excuse in order to be permitted to take the exam. This includes exams given in class. The penalty for an unexcused missed exam is a **zero**.
4. Seniors may be exempt from exams following these guidelines:
 - The teacher of the course decides whether or not seniors may be exempt from that exam.
 - It must be a **full year** course.
 - Student has earned an "A-" or greater for the first semester **and** has an "A-" average for both third and fourth quarters.
 - The [Senior Exam Exemption Permission Form](#) must be submitted, complete with teacher signatures, to **Mrs. Teeple**s by **Monday, May 6, 2019**.
